Call for the Participation in the Fusion Education and Learning Hub

EUROfusion is developing the **Fusion Education and Learning Hub (FuEL)**, a new online learning platform to host academic-level, on-demand and/or live university courses and training programs. This activity is part of the EUROfusion Knowledge Management Strategy and makes undergraduate, graduate, and post-graduate education and training accessible across Europe to EUROfusion students, experts, and collaborators. The platform will use the open-source software Moodle used in multiple European universities.

The initial courses offered for 2024 are expected to fall into the following categories:

1. Recording of an existing university course offered as on-demand course on the platform with 1-2 office hours by the lecturer. (Funding: 0.5pm per course)
2. Repetition of an existing university course live online with around 10-12 lectures organized weekly during the semester or condensed into a 1-2-week course. (Funding: 1pm per course)

The plan is to launch the new learning platform with 6 recorded and 3 live courses in October to December 2024. The system will be tested and optimized jointly with lecturers and students and is expected to expand with further courses in 2025 with a new call to be launched. This expansion will cover the following categories:

3. Adaption of an existing course or creation of a new course in on-demand online MOOC format.
4. Repository of problem sets, (Capstone) projects and activities for standard undergraduate courses to include fusion examples as well as courses dedicated to nuclear fusion.

Funding is provided for the lecturers and universities under the Training and Education work package (WPTRED) to reimburse the time commitment to adapt the courses to the online platform.

With the present letter I invite you to submit proposals and expression of interests to participate in the first phase of the Fusion Education and Learning Hub. Please submit your proposals not later than **20 September 2024, 23:59 CEST** to be considered in the first selection round through

Personal Data Protection (GDPR)

The EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is a privacy and data protection regulation in the European Union with effect from the 25th May 2018. The GDPR imposes obligations on organisations that control or process personal data and introduces rights and protections for EU citizens. EUROfusion is committed to ensuring that proponents' privacy is protected and strictly adhere to the provisions of all relevant Data Protection legislation, including GDPR, ensuring all personal data is handled in line with the principles outlined in the regulation.

In compliance with article 13 of the GDPR, EUROfusion provides the following information:

Type of Data processed:

The personal data collected within the present call for participation will be processed for the sole use of the evaluation and selection of courses for the Fusion Education and Learning Hub.

The proponents express their consent to the processing of personal data (GDPR, art. 6, par. 1, letter a) necessary for carrying out the selection procedure and to allow EUROfusion Programme Management Unit (PMU) to fulfil the obligations related to the Grant Agreement (GDPR, art. 6, par. 1, letter b).

The data will be processed:

- through the use of manual and automated systems;
- by people authorized to carry out these tasks, pursuant to the law;
- with the adoption of adequate measures to guarantee the security of the data and to prevent access to the same by unauthorized third parties.

There are no automated decision-making processes.

The recipients of the personal data are the EUROfusion PMU members involved in the process and the evaluation panel that may include external experts.

The personal data collected for the purpose of the selection will be stored for the period of the evaluation process.

The proponents are entitled to the rights of access (GDPR, Article 15), rectification (GDPR, Article 16), erasure (GDPR, Article 17, para. 1), restriction of processing (GDPR, Article 18), data portability (GDPR, Article 20) and withdrawal of consent (GDPR, Article 7, para. 3). They also have the right to submit an objection to the supervisory authority.
